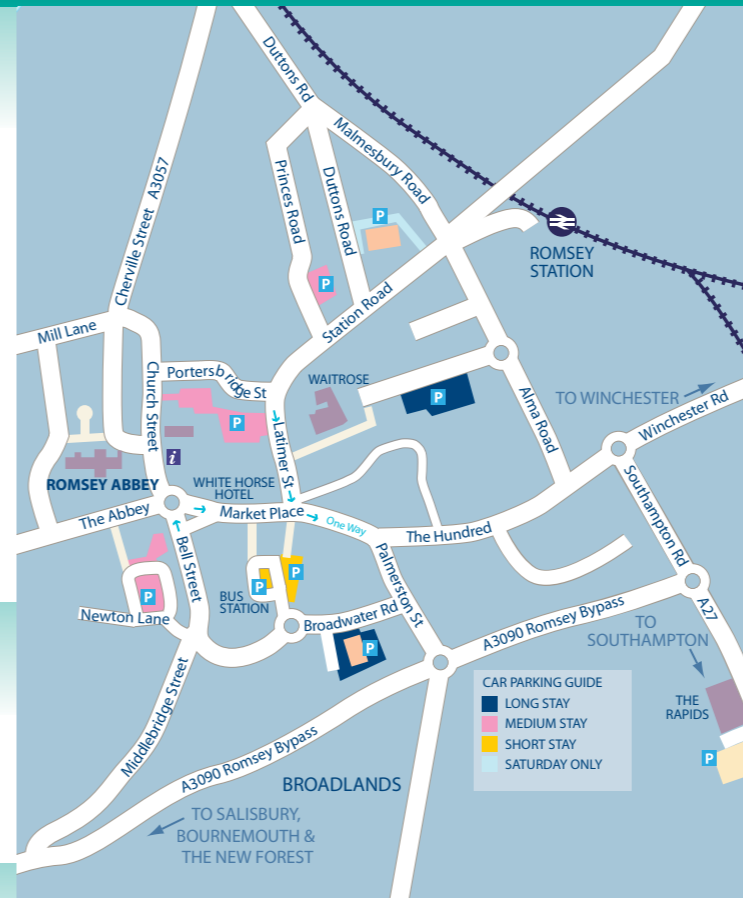

with pedestrian access to Church Street and the Abbey

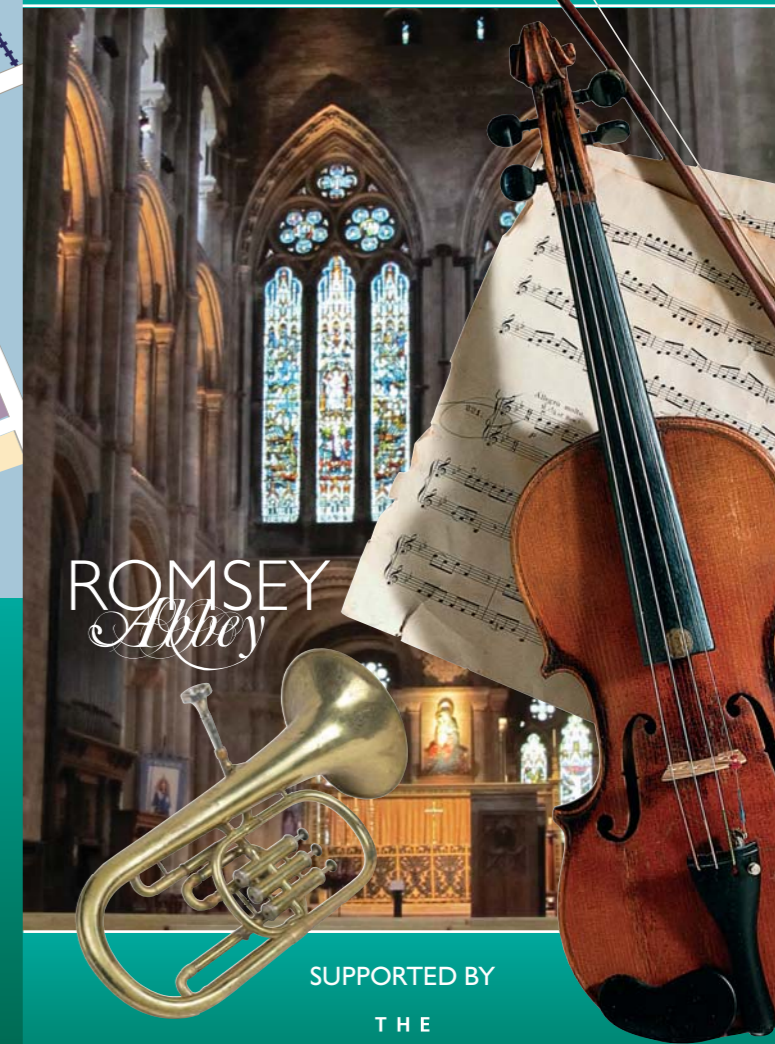
Newton Lane car park, (which has 70 places) has pedestrian

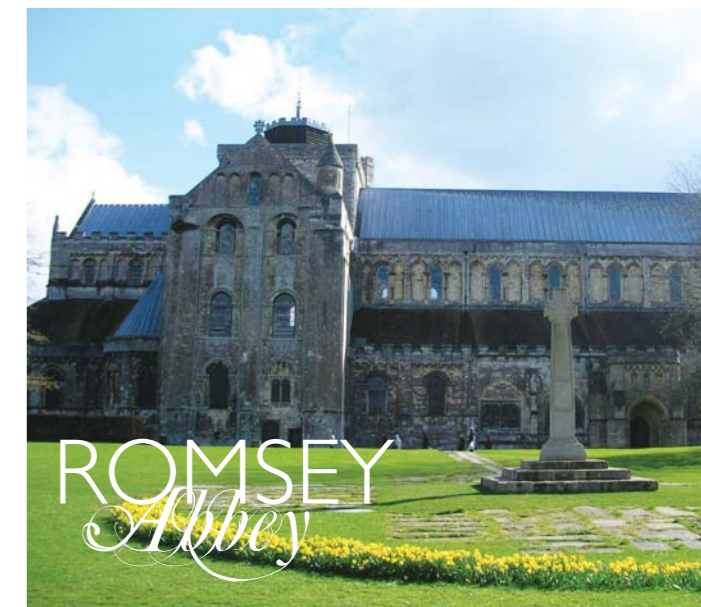
